## 2010 Pool Rules

The Fieldstone Crossing pool is for the use and enjoyment of all Fieldstone Crossing Owners, Residents, Family members and their Guests. The pool rules are designed to help provide maximum enjoyment for all and to protect their health and rights of usage.

The pool will be open from 5:00 in the morning to 9:00 at night. Everyone is to leave the facility at the closing time of 9:00 pm. The hours of operation are in place in consideration for nearby homeowners. These hours will be enforced so please comply voluntarily and avoid loss of privileges. Hours may need to be adjusted if noise levels are offensive per city code.

**There is no lifeguard on duty at any time.** An adult, age 18 and older, must accompany children under 14 years of age. Children under 14 must be closely supervised at all times. This means a responsible party must be in or near the pools at all times when their children are using the pools. This includes the wading pool. Resident youths 14 - 17 years may swim without an adult.

A cleansing shower before use is essential for both people and pools. It keeps the pool healthy by not clogging the filters with lotions. It keeps you healthy because pool chemicals are naturally drawn to dry skin and are absorbed by your body very quickly if it is dry.

Food and drink in non-breakable containers is allowed on the pool deck but please be conscious of keeping the pools clean by not having food or drink in the pools themselves. Those bringing consumables into the pool area will be responsible for cleaning up and disposing of trash generated.

Owners/Residents enjoy sharing the facility with their family and friends, but to do so you need to accompany them to the pool site. Please limit the number of guests at any one time to six. This number can be slightly flexible in some circumstances as long as it is not abused. For instance, if you have seven out of town guests staying with you then the association would not insist that one had to remain out of the pool. If you want to have a larger organized event, i.e. a birthday party, please contact Crystal Lake Property Management to inform us of the date, time and anticipated number of guests. Providing our office with this information will help alleviate the occurrence of multiple parties at the same time, overcrowding the pool, and disrupting other members' use. Members may reserve the Pool and Pavilion areas for group functions during one of two time slots: [12 noon to 3:30 PM] OR [3:30 PM to 7:00 PM]. Please see the **Facility Reservation Policy** for details. Reservations do not assure exclusive use.

This is a public facility and a family community therefore public nudity and skinny-dipping are strictly prohibited. If this behavior is observed, please contact Crystal Lake Property Management and action will be taken.

Please bring your pool card for access. Do not ask someone inside the facility to open the gate for you, and do not prop the gate open! With a beautiful facility such as this, inevitably non-members will try to access the facility for a free swim, especially as the weather gets nicer. Please do not open the gate for someone who does not have a pool card. Do not climb the fence as this damages the fencing. Please report anyone climbing the fence for access to the pool to Crystal Lake Property Management, or if after hours contact the police department. While this seems harsh, this unacceptable behavior is only encouraged and then repeated when it is not dealt with.

Owners are asked to thoroughly go over these rules and regulations with each member of your household, or lessees of your property, to make sure they understand and will comply. The Fieldstone Crossing Owners Association has the right to suspend the pool privileges of any member or tenant who is in violation of the pool rules and regulations.

## Pool Facility Rules and Regulations

1. THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY!!
2. Pools are for the exclusive use of Owners, Residents, Family members and their Guests. Owners are to accompany and assume responsibility for guests. The maximum number of guests is six. Unauthorized users of this facility will be considered trespassers and subject to police intervention.
3. All Owners/ Residents are to gain access to the facility via their pool card. Do not leave the gate open, or allow others without pool cards to gain entry to the facility. Non-members will try to gain access to the facility but please do not to open the gate for anyone unless you personally recognize them as a fellow member. Do not climb the fence to gain access to the pool area.
4. Children who are 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult age 18 or older. An adult may accompany a maximum of four children under the age of 14.
5. Groups of youths, age 14 – 17, are limited to six in number. Groups of seven or more youths are required to be accompanied by an adult.
6. Pool hours are 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily. The pool may be temporarily closed for routine chemical maintenance or equipment repair during these hours on an as needed basis to ensure safety of all users. (Your cooperation during this time is appreciated.)
7. All Owners/ Residents and their guests must vacate the pool facility at the 9:00 p.m. closing time. Persons observed to violate this shall be considered trespassers and subject to police intervention.
8. All persons must take a cleansing shower before entering the pool.
9. No person with a communicable disease transmittable via water shall use the pool.
10. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall use the pool.
11. Running, engaging in horseplay, shoving, pushing, ball throwing (exception: soft beach balls) are not permitted in or around the pool for the safety of all.
12. No diving at any time! The pools are not deep enough for safe diving.
13. No smoking, glass containers, use of profanity, skateboarding, bicycles, roller blades or pets shall be allowed at this facility.
14. Trash shall be disposed of properly in the receptacles provided.
15. Floatation devises must be rinsed before placing them in pools. Please exercise consideration for other pool users when using these devises in the pool. Floating toys of any size that contain glitter are prohibited as they clog up the filter. Take your pool toys home with you after each pool visit.
16. Children who are not potty trained must wear plastic pants or swim diapers when in the pool. All disposable diapers must be disposed of properly.
17. The Fieldstone Crossing Owners Association has the right to suspend pool privileges of any Owners/ Residents who violate pool rules.
18. The Fieldstone Crossing Owners Association assumes no responsibility for accidents, injuries, or loss of personal property. Each person who enters the pool area does so at his or her own risk.
